

Conference Workshop Descriptions

CTSO / Perkins – Department of Education Consultants will talk about how Perkins and CTSO's can interact. Bring your questions about affiliate membership, chapter jackets, travel, training materials, registrations and the like.

Fundraising / Activity Fund – Department of Education Consultants will highlight changes in Iowa law and practice. A great workshop to ask questions in a friendly environment.

Local Program Policies – Join State FFA Staff in a discussion about the relationship between local school district policies and local FFA chapter policies (constitution & by-laws, etc.). Community booster/support group branding and role will also be addressed. Come to this session with access to your local chapter constitution & by-laws.

ALL IN for Ag Education – Dr. Paulsen and Elsa Schmidt will review our Team Ag Ed strategic plan and how we can make a 'Big Lift' towards 2029.

Kreg Tools – Mike Maruziak and his team has a project in mind and has a team of Kreg team members lined up to help as needed, this is going to be a great experience for participants.

Vernier – Karen VanDeWalle and Jamie Christiansen will be showcasing the Vernier Go Direct sensors that connect to computers, Chromebooks, LabQuest 3, tablets, or mobile devices.

Ag Broadcasting CDE – Andy Petersen the morning Farm News Anchor at WHO-AM and co-host of the Big Show will offer insights on how to prepare your students for the Ag Broadcasting CDE. Each participation will walk away with a practice guide.

USDA Grant Cohort – The purpose of this project is to train secondary agricultural education instructors in how to best teach foundational skills like record keeping, personal finance, and agricultural business to be applied with students and their supervised agricultural experience (SAE) programs. *These efforts align with work-based learning which is an important topic that is covered by Future Ready Iowa, STEM, and Perkins V.* USDA NIFA Grant -- "**SAE For ALL: Developing Teacher Resources and Training to Build Student Foundational Skills"**. This grant will pay for instructors' registration, travel, lodging and meals while in attendance at grant activities along with a first year subscription to The AET. We will do 2 more cohorts in 2022 and 2023.

Nursery/Landscaping CDE – Adam Crews from Louisa-Muscatine will be conducting a hands-on workshop which will help you train your students for the Equipment Safety & Operation or Team Skills Challenge part of the CDE.

Floriculture CDE – Louise Fleming from Vinton will be conducting a hands-on workshop which will help you train your students for the Floral Design/Corsage part of the CDE.

Soils Evaluation CDE – Amber Anderson from Iowa State University will be conducting an interactive workshop which will help you train your students for this CDE using the updated Soil Judging in Iowa Handbook and newly developed computer simulations.

Ag Mechanics CDE – Jim Green from St. Ansgar and Jon Davis from Gilbert will be conducting a hands-on workshop which will help you prepare your students for the skill areas of Land Measurement/Surveying and Electrical Wiring of outlets/switches.

Farm Credit Services Grant Program – Teresa Mardesen from FCS will provide ideas suggestions to completing a successful grant application that agricultural educators can complete used to purchase classroom supplies, develop Student SAEs and/or complete FFA

NFFA – Bridget Mahoney from Lone Tree and Ben Meyer from National FFA will share Educator Resources that are available to agricultural educators through the website.

Self Studies – RPP 3, 10 and 11. Any instructors who have yet to submit a self-study are welcome to attend. (description already in agenda)

Cherry Glen – Ray Meylor and the Cherry Glen Learning Farm will host instructors for the afternoon engaging colleagues in a wide variety of land laboratory learning opportunities. Be prepared to pick up new ideas to implement as part of your future outdoor learning lab plans!
