## Conference Workshop Descriptions

**Ag Communications** - Is Ag Communications always a contest you've avoided? Come learn about the tips and tricks to make your ag communications team a success next year! Topics to be covered will be media plan, presentations, and practicums. Renee Hanson from Sukup will be joining us to recreate the press conference and provide you an opportunity to develop example practicums to take home.

**Ag Issues CDE** – While participating in the Ag Issues and Perceptions CDE students will engage in the selection, research, planning and presentation of local, state, national or international agriculture issues. In this workshop, you will discover tips and tricks on how to select a perfect topic, write an engaging script, and understand the pro/con debate process. Aside from the presentation, you will also learn about high-quality forums and how to properly set students up for success when preparing for this contest.

**Agronomy CDE** – Join ISU Agronomy faculty for a workshop focused on the State FFA Agronomy CDE. The workshop will share proposed changes for the 2023 event and you will get hands-on experience with the plant and seed identification portion of the event.

**Conduct of Chapter Meetings** – Parliamentary procedure starts here! It's not just a leadership development event. It is a resource that students can use for the rest of their life. The curriculum needs to start with the basics of parliamentary procedure so as to create a solid foundation. Join Joe Yedlik to discuss parli pro for the sake of your chapter meetings as well as the LDEs.

**Diversity/Equity/Inclusion** – Are you trying to find ways to encourage diversity/equity/inclusion in your classroom? We will identify ways to include all learners in the classroom and on FFA trips.

**Extemporaneous Speaking CDE** – Join Clyde Johnson and other members of the Extemporaneous Speaking LDE committee to learn tips and tools for being involved In Extemporaneous Speaking and how to get your students involved as advocates for current topics in agriculture.

**Farm to Table (ISU Extension)** - Join Chelsea Krist from the Farm, Food and Enterprise Development (FFED) program to learn how your Ag Education program can be a part of the Iowa Food System Coalition as well as other efforts around Farm to School. This will be a two part session to discuss statewide farm to school and early care work and Iowa Food System Coalition vision and values.

**Food Science CDE** – Have you ever wanted to participate in the Food Science CDE but wasn't sure what it would take or felt overwhelmed reading the rules? You will get hands-on experience participating in the various skills portions of the Food Science CDE. We will go over the triangle tests, purchasing/storing aromas, practicum advice, and do a quick walk through of the team development activity.

**Natural Resources Curriculum** - The Conservation Science curriculum engages students in doing science and developing important skills such as critical thinking, problem solving, communication, data collection, etc. The curriculum focuses on the North American Model of Wildlife Conservation and the related outdoor recreation: Hunting, fishing, trapping, shooting sports and boating. Students learn and develop skills related to relevant and applicable topics.

**Now What?** – Join State Staff to receive updates from developments and changes made to workshop topics that were presented last year. This workshop will commit most of its time on the latest guidance on activity account management (released in March of 2022) and FFA branding & licensing.

**Parliamentary Procedure Contest Preparation** - A Skill For Life Exploring parliamentary procedure at the grassroots and advanced levels for both LDE participation as well as use within life! Join Ellen Doese to explore resources, curriculum ideas, preparation materials, and the how to's of motions will be addressed.

**Post-Secondary** – Do you teach a dual credit course or want to explore your options? This workshop is for you to find out the expectations of high school educators teaching a college level course. Exchange ideas of what works and get a better understanding of the expectations the post-secondary institutions have for you.

**Self Advocacy – Ryan Goodman: Advocacy In Action** - Following his morning keynote, join Ryan Goodman to learn tips and tools for applying advocacy best practices in your role as an educator and how to get your students involved as advocates for agriculture.

**Self Care – Elsa Schmidt** This will be a chance for you to share what works for you and ask those tough questions of how to make time for yourself and your family. What questions do you have about time management, work-family balance, trying new activities, and how to work with administrators. This workshop will be tailored to those in attendance.

**Vet Science CDE** – Have you ever wanted to have students participate in the Vet Science CDE but weren't sure what it would take or felt overwhelmed reading the rules? You will get hands-on experience participating in the various parts of the CDE. Practical tips and tricks will be presented about the 2023 clinical procedure practicum topics of this CDE.

**USDA Grant Cohort** – The purpose of this project is to train secondary agricultural education instructors in how to best teach foundational skills like record keeping, personal finance, and agricultural business to be applied with students and their supervised agricultural experience (SAE) programs. *These efforts align with work-based learning which is an important topic that is covered by Future Ready Iowa, STEM, and Perkins V.* USDA NIFA Grant -- **“SAE For ALL: Developing Teacher Resources and Training to Build Student Foundational Skills”**. This grant will pay for instructors' registration, travel, lodging and meals while in attendance at grant activities along with a first year subscription to The AET. We will do 2 more cohorts in 2023 and 2024.

## **Post Conference Workshops:**

**CASE (AG X)** – Registration through Dr Smalley and CASE website

**Drone Certification** – This hands-on activity will take you through the training process of the Part 107 certification. If you have a drone, bring it along for some hands-on training. You will be ready to take your Part 107 after completion of the course. A small materials fee will be included with the registration of the class.

**Greenhouse Management** – Don Josko. If you are looking for guidance on working with your greenhouse and making it more efficient, this is your workshop. You will get hands-on experience working with many different greenhouse products. He will go over adjusting your fertilizer injector, the various types of soils used in a greenhouse, chemical usage, and the various types of plastic growing containers, just to name a few. Bring some sealed baggies for samples and a marker to identify your sample.
